The Equipment is sold "as is" and "where is" and the description of the Equipment is for the sole purpose of identifying it and is not part of the basis of the bargain.

And Seller does for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant and agree with Purchaser, its successors and assigns, that Seller is sole lawful owner of the Equipment and is fully empowered to transfer title to Purchaser, and title is hereby transferred to Purchaser free and clear of all liens, charges, liabilities, claims, security interests, and encumbrances created by or arising through the Seller; and Seller warrants to defend the sale and title of the Equipment unto Purchaser, its successors and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever claiming or laying claim to the same, by, through, or under Seller or its predecessors in interest, except for any defects in title or liens or encumbrances in or

to the Equipment arising by reason of Purchaser's own acts.

THE WARRANTY SET FORTH IN THE FOREGOING PARAGRAPH IS EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES OF SELLER, WHETHER WRITTEN, ORAL, OR IMPLIED, AND SELLER SHALL NOT, BY VIRTUE OF HAVING SOLD THE EQUIPMENT HERewith, BE DEEMED TO HAVE MADE ANY REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY AS TO THE MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS, DESIGN, OR CONDITION OF, OR AS TO THE QUALITY OF THE MATERIAL OR WORKMANSHIP IN, THE EQUIPMENT.

This Bill of Sale is simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which so executed is deemed to be an original, and such counterparts together constitute but one and the same instrument.
