

SATISFACTION AND RELEASE dated as of November 1, 1993, by Mercantile-Safe Deposit and Trust Company, as Trustee (the "Trustee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Trustee and United States Trust Company of New York, as Owner Trustee (the "Owner Trustee") under a Trust Agreement dated as of April 1, 1975, with General Electric Capital Corporation (formerly known as General Electric Credit Corporation) entered into an Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of April 1, 1975 (the "Agreement"), covering certain railroad equipment described in Schedule A thereto (the "Equipment");

WHEREAS, the Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") on May 2, 1975 and assigned Recordation No. 7917;

WHEREAS, the Owner Trustee and Trailer Train Company ("Trailer Train") entered into a Lease of Railroad Equipment (the "Lease"), dated as of April 1, 1975, covering the Equipment;

WHEREAS, the Lease was filed and recorded with the ICC on May 2, 1975, and assigned Recordation No. 7917-A;

WHEREAS, the Trustee and the Owner Trustee entered into an Assignment of Lease and Agreement (the "Lease Assignment"), dated as of April 1, 1975, with respect to the Lease;

WHEREAS, the Lease Assignment was filed and recorded with the ICC on May 2, 1975, and assigned Recordation No. 7917-B;

WHEREAS, the Trustee desires to execute this Instrument to evidence for public records the satisfaction and release of the obligations of the Owner Trustee under the Equipment Trust Agreement and the Lease Assignment.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Trustee does hereby (a) acknowledge the satisfaction and release of all the covenants, obligations, liens, and warranties of the Owner Trustee under the Agreement and the Lease Assignment and (b) transfer, convey, assign, and release to the Owner Trustee all the right, title, and interest of the Trustee in and to the Equipment;

The Owner Trustee will cause this Instrument to be filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 11303, and will furnish a recorded counterpart thereof to the Owner Trustee.

This Instrument shall be executed in several counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and such counterparts together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
