Notice is hereby given that on January 11, 1993, The Connecticut National Bank changed its name to Shawmut Bank Connecticut, National Association ("Shawmut Bank"). The name change was a change in legal name only; no other corporate action was involved. Shawmut Bank continues to maintain its principal corporate trust office at 777 Main Street, Hartford, CT 06115. Enclosed with this letter is a Certificate issued by the Comptroller of the Currency evidencing the name change.

Shawmut Bank acts as owner trustee in railroad rolling stock lease transactions where certain of the financing instruments are filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission (the "ICC"). We retained special ICC counsel, who advised us to notify the ICC on a transactional basis of our name change. Accordingly, please amend your records with respect to the following filings to reflect the name change to Shawmut Bank:


