

As of the 31st day of March, 1975, a Security Agreement (the "Agreement") was entered into between Continental Bank, National Association, a national banking association, as Owner Trustee (the "Owner Trustee"), and Mellon Bank, N.A., a Pennsylvania corporation, as Security Trustee (the "Security Trustee").

The Agreement was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on June 13, 1975 at 1:05 p.m. and assigned Recordation Number 7961.

All amounts due and owing the Security Trustee pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Agreement have been paid in full and all indebtedness therein created has been fully satisfied by the Owner Trustee.


For good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Security Trustee hereby releases, discharges and terminates all of its right, title and interest in all of the railroad equipment mentioned and described in the Agreement. The Security Trustee makes no representation or warranties of any kind hereby, express or implied, including as to the present existence or condition of said equipment.
