THIS LEASE SUPPLEMENT NO. 4 dated August 24, 1992 between THE CONNECTICUT NATIONAL BANK, not individually but solely as Owner Trustee ("*Lessor*"), and NORTHERN INDIANA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY, an Indiana corporation ("*Lessee*"),

WITNESSETH:

1. Lessor and Lessee have heretofore entered into a Railcar Lease dated as of July 1, 1992 (the "*Lease*") providing for the execution and delivery of Lease Supplements substantially in the form hereof. The terms defined in the Lease shall have the same meanings when used herein.

4. Lessee hereby certifies that such Purchase Price for the Equipment is \$5,994,216.00.

5. Interim Rent for the Equipment is payable in the amount set forth in Section 6(a) of the Lease on January 1, 1993. Fixed Rent, Stipulated Loss Values and Termination Values for the Equipment is payable in the amounts and on the Rent Payment Dates set forth in Schedule 2 attached hereto.


