
WHEREOF, in consideration of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration:

BA Leasing & Capital Corporation does hereby declare said Agreement dated as of February 25, 1980, other than section 14 in the CSL entitled Survival of Covenants, and all supplements thereto, to be satisfied and cancelled and does consent that the same be discharged of record, and further, in compliance with Section 7 of the Schedule, said BA Leasing & Capital Corporation does hereby sell, assign and convey, unto CSX Transportation, Inc., as successor by merger to the C&O, all of its right, title, and interest in and to all of the railroad equipment of every character included in said attachment, entitled "Schedule A", without representations or warranties except that such railroad equipment is free and clear of all claims, liens, security interests and other encumbrances by or in favor of any person claiming by, through or under Lessor.
