

**TERMINATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Texas Commerce Bank - San Antonio ("TCB") and Railtex, Inc. ("Railtex") are party to Security Agreements (the "Agreements") covering sixty (60) hopper cars bearing reporting marks and numbers TRAX 1050 through 1099 and TRAX 110 through 119 (the "cars").

WHEREAS, the Agreements were filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on July 3, 1979 and July 10, 1979 and bear Recordation numbers 10586 and 10617 and

WHEREAS, TCB and Railtex desire to terminate the Agreements and desire to release the liens, assignments and security interest created pursuant to the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and for other valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree:

1. Termination. The Agreement is terminated and the cars are released from the liens, assignment and security interest created thereunder.

2. Filing. The parties consent to the filing of this Agreement and any other necessary documents with the Interstate Commerce Commission (and, if necessary, with any other regulatory or governmental entity) to affect a release of all liens of record existing against the cars.

3. Counterparts. The Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties hereto in separated counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement 09-17-93 to be effective June 5, 1989.


