

**DECLARATION OF FULL PAYMENT**

First Interstate Bank of Denver, N.A. (formerly The First National Bank of Denver, herein called the "Trustee"), Trustee under that certain Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of May 1, 1982, as supplemented, between the Trustee and The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company, pursuant to which was created and constituted "Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Equipment Trust, Series SS," does hereby acknowledge and declare that the purchase money for the equipment subject to said Equipment Trust Agreement has been paid in full; that all of the terms and conditions of the said Equipment Trust Agreement, as supplemented, have been performed; that The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company has made all payments and met all charges required by the said Equipment Trust Agreement, as supplemented; that all of the interests in Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company Equipment Trust, Series SS, and the dividends thereon, have been satisfied, paid and discharged; and the said Equipment Trust Agreement, as supplemented, and the lease by Trustee to The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company of the railroad equipment described therein, have terminated, and the Trustee is now obligated by the said Equipment Trust Agreement to assign and

transfer the said railroad equipment to The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company as the absolute property of The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company.

AND it does hereby consent that the record of its title to all the equipment covered by the said Equipment Trust Agreement, as supplemented, be cancelled and discharged, and that this Declaration may be filed or recorded or noted on the margin of the record of the said Equipment Trust Agreement wherever the same may have been filed or recorded.


AND it does hereby constitute and appoint CHERYL HANSON to be its attorney for it, and in its name and as and for its corporate act and deed, to acknowledge this instrument, before any person having authority by the laws of the State of Colorado or elsewhere to take such acknowledgement, to the intent that the same may be duly recorded.
