To whom it may concern:

Please find enclosed two separate release documents, each of which are releasing specific security agreements against certain railroad cars. The first is a release (secondary document) as to primary document numbers 13578, 13578a, and 11127 which are security agreements. The release pertains to the following railroad tank cars: TGPX33501-33510, 32813-32821, and 32304. These are tank railroad cars. This release has been executed by Fidelity National Bank of West Memphis, Arkansas and releases the original of the security agreements that were conveyed by Tamak Transportation Corporation to Fidelity.

The second release of lien concerns a release of primary document number ~~14188~~ 14188 which is a security agreement. This security agreement pertains to railroad tank cars numbered TGPX 32801 through 32812. Parties to the original security agreement were First Tennessee Bank National Association as a secured party and Tamak Transportation Corporation as the grantor. RELEASE OF LIENS AND SECURITY AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, by a certain Security Agreement of record under recordation number 14188 originally recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission, **TAMAK TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION** ("Tamak") conveyed to **FIRST TENNESSEE BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION**, f/k/a First Tennessee Bank, N.A., Memphis ("First Tennessee"), a security interest in the railroad tank cars numbered TGPX 32801 through 32812 for the purpose of securing the payment of an indebtedness evidenced by note(s) fully described in the Security Agreement;

WHEREAS, all of the notes described in and secured by said security agreement have been paid in full, and there is nothing due or owing on said indebtedness nor under the terms and provisions of said security agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the undersigned, First Tennessee, as the legal owner and holder of the notes secured by said security agreement, acknowledges full payment and satisfaction thereof, and hereby releases and discharges the lien of said security agreement of record at recordation numbers 14188, and to this end quitclaim(s) and convey(s) unto the said Tamak, its heirs and assigns all of its right, title and interest in and to the railroad tank cars described in said security agreement, to which reference is made for a particular description of said property.

The undersigned, First Tennessee Bank National Association, covenants with the said Tamak Transportation Corporation that it is the legal owner and holder of the note(s) described in and secured by said security agreement, and that it has the lawful right to release and discharge the lien thereof.
