

INSTRUMENT OF LEASE TERMINATION AND SATISFACTION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Southern Region Industrial Realty, Inc. (the "Lessor"), the lessor under an Agreement dated as of May 8, 1980 (the "Agreement"), between the Lessor and Norfolk Southern Railway Company (formerly named Southern Railway Company) (the "Railroad"), providing for the lease to the Railroad of certain railroad equipment, hereby certifies and confirms that all of the obligations of the Railroad under the Agreement have been fully complied with and performed and that the Agreement terminated in accordance with its terms.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Lessor hereby acknowledges and declares that the Agreement was and remains satisfied, terminated and canceled, consents that the same be discharged and released of record, hereby sells, assigns, conveys, transfers, sets over, releases and quitclaims unto the Railroad and its subsidiary companies and its or their successors and assigns, as their interests may appear, as its and their absolute property, all of the Lessor's right, title and interest in and to the railroad equipment subject to the Agreement and releases the Railroad, its successors and assigns, from any and all obligations of the Agreement.
