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RELEASE OF RAILCAR LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WHEREAS, First Security Bank of Utah, N.A., not in its individual capacity, but solely as trustee under a Master Trust Agreement dated as of June 13, 1979 between it and Dial Leasing Corporation as Owner Trustee, ("Trustee") have heretofore executed and delivered an Indenture dated as of June 18, 1979 (the "Indenture") to Central Life Assurance Company (the "Secured Party"); and

WHEREAS, Trustee entered into an Equipment Lease Agreement (the "Lease"), with Glass Containers Corporation which was duly recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission (the "ICC") pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §11303 on November 5, 1979 under Recordation Number 11001. The Indenture was duly recorded and filed with the ICC on November 5, 1979 under Recordation Number 11001-A. Trustee subsequently entered into a Supplemental Indenture ("Supplement No. 1") with Lender, which was recorded with the ICC on November 5, 1979 under Recordation Number 11001-B. Trustee entered into another Supplemental Indenture ("Supplement No. 2") with Lender, which was recorded with the ICC on November 5, 1979 under Recordation Number 11001-C. The rail equipment subject to the Indenture is described on the attached Schedule A (the "Equipment"); and

Secured Party desires to execute this Instrument to evidence for the public record the satisfaction and release of all of its rights and obligations under the foregoing documents and to evidence the termination of the Indenture.

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the delivery of this Release have been complied with by the Trustee and its successors and assigns.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secured Party, for due consideration, pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.01 of the Indenture, does hereby RELEASE, DEMISE, CONVEY AND QUITCLAIM unto the Trustee and its successor and assigns whatever right, title, lien or interest which the Secured Party has or may have under the Indenture or by virtue of the recording of the Indenture with the ICC pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §11303.
