

WHEREAS, First Security Bank of Utah, N.A., as Trustee under a Master Trust Agreement dated as of October 1, 1976, ("Trustee") has heretofore executed and delivered a Trust Indenture dated as of October 1, 1976, a Supplemental Indenture dated as of September 1, 1978 and an Amendment Agreement Number One to Supplemental Indenture dated as of September 1, 1978, (collectively, the "Indenture Documents") to United States Trust Company of New York (the "Secured Party"); and
