

RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, to secure certain indebtedness, CSC Enterprises, Inc. ("Enterprises") has heretofore granted to First Bank of Illinois (formerly known as First Bank & Trust Company of O'Fallon) (the "Bank") a security interest in and to 19 100-ton 4750 cubic-foot covered hopper railcars bearing the car reporting marks and numbers set forth on Schedule A hereto (the "Equipment") pursuant to that certain Security Agreement dated June 1, 1988 (the "Security Agreement") between Enterprises and the Bank; and

WHEREAS, the Security Agreement was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on June 28, 1988 as Recordation No. 15697; and

WHEREAS, said indebtedness so secured having been satisfied, the Bank desires to release its security interest in and to the Equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency whereof are hereby acknowledged, the Bank, for itself and its successors and assigns, hereby releases, remises, reconveys and retransfers to and unto Enterprises, its successors and assigns, all of the Bank's rights, titles and interests in and to the Equipment.
