This MEMORANDUM OF RAILROAD EQUIPMENT LEASE ("Memorandum of Lease") entered into this 14th day of September, 2000, is intended to evidence the lease dated as of September 14, 2000 (the "Lease"), between **JOSEPH TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, INC.**, a Delaware corporation ("Lessor"), and **WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY**, a Washington corporation ("Lessee"), for the purpose of satisfying the requirements of recordation with the Surface Transportation Board under Section 49 of U.S.C. 11301. 


