**FULL RELEASE OF  
MEMORANDUM OF COMMERCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD  
AND  
MEMORANDUM OF (COLLATERAL) ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES AND RENTS**

THIS FULL RELEASE OF MEMORANDUM OF COMMERCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT AND MEMORANDUM OF (COLLATERAL) ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES AND RENTS (this "Release") is given as of this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2005, by ASSOCIATED BANK MINNESOTA, an Illinois corporation (the "Secured Party"), witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the Secured Party and Midwest Railcar Corporation, an Illinois corporation ("Midwest"), entered into that certain Memorandum of Commercial Security Agreement and that certain Memorandum of (Collateral) Assignment of Leases and Rents, each dated as of June 3, 2002, recorded with the Surface Transportation Board under recordation numbers 23827-E and 23827-F, respectively (collectively, the "Memoranda"), pursuant to which Midwest granted the Secured Party a security interest in one (1) hopper car more specifically described on Schedule 1 attached hereto (the "Equipment") and assigned to the Secured Party, as collateral, its rights, title and interest in and to that certain Rider 1 to Full Service Lease Agreement, each dated March 15, 2002 and each by and between Midwest, as lessor, and Badger Mining Corporation, as lessee (collectively, the "Lease").
