This Release of Lien of Railroad Equipment Lease (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Railroad Equipment Lease dated as of March 23, 2000 (the "Lease"), bearing Recordation No. 22905, between The David J. Joseph Company (f/k/a Joseph Transportation Services, Inc.) as Lessor ("Lessor") and LBC PetroUnited, Inc., as Lessee ("Lessee"), with respect to the one (1) locomotive bearing the reporting mark DJPX 23 (hereinafter, the "Equipment").


