

MEMORANDUM OF TRUST INDENTURE AND SECURITY AGREEMENT AND TRUST
INDENTURE SUPPLEMENT NO. 6
(Surface Transportation Board) SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD

THIS MEMORANDUM OF TRUST INDENTURE AND SECURITY AGREEMENT AND TRUST INDENTURE SUPPLEMENT NO. 6 ("Memorandum"), dated as of February 27, 2007, is between WILMINGTON TRUST COMPANY, not individually but solely as Indenture Trustee ("Indenture Trustee"), and WELLS FARGO BANK NORTHWEST, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, not individually but solely as Owner Trustee ("Owner Trustee").

The parties to this Memorandum hereby acknowledge and confirm the following:

A. Owner Trustee has granted to the Indenture Trustee a security interest in all of Owner Trustee's right, title and interest in those certain railcars identified on Schedule 1 attached hereto (the "Equipment"), as indicated pursuant to the terms of that certain Trust Indenture and Security Agreement (DPC Trust 2006-1), dated as of September 28, 2006, and that certain Trust Indenture Supplement No. 6, dated as of February 27, 2007, between the Indenture Trustee and Owner Trustee.

B. In addition, other than Excepted Property, Owner Trustee has granted to the Indenture Trustee a security interest in that certain Equipment Lease Agreement (DPC Trust 2006-1) dated as of September 28, 2006, and that certain Lease Supplement No. 6 relating to the Equipment, dated as of February 27, 2007, between Owner Trustee, as Lessor, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (f/k/a Duke Power Company LLC), as the Lessee.

C. The parties hereto wish to show for public record this Memorandum and accordingly have caused this Memorandum to be executed by their officers thereunto duly authorized, as of the date first above written.

D. This Memorandum may be executed in counterparts, each such counterpart shall be binding on both parties hereto, notwithstanding that both parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
