**MEMORANDUM OF AMENDED AND RESTATED EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION
(SPT 1995-C)****SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD**

Memorandum of Amended and Restated Equipment Description (SPT 1995-C) effective as of January 2, 2008, by and between U.S. Bank National Association (successor-in-interest to Shawmut Bank Connecticut, National Association), a national banking association, not in its individual capacity, but solely as Owner Trustee of the SPT 1995-C Trust, as Lessor ("*Lessor*"), and Union Pacific Railroad Company (successor to Southern Pacific Transportation Company), a Delaware corporation, as Lessee ("*Lessee*").

WITNESSETH:

1. The undersigned have entered into an Equipment Lease Agreement (SPT 1995-C) dated as of April 28, 1995 (as amended, supplemented or modified, the "*Lease*"), whereby the Lessor has agreed to lease to Lessee and Lessee has agreed to lease from the Lessor certain railroad equipment.


