

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD

This Partial Release of Lease Agreement Lien (the "Partial Release") releases the lien created by that certain Railroad Equipment Lease dated as of April 12, 1995, (the Lease), bearing Recordation No. 19380 filed on May 1, 1995, between Wisconsin Central Ltd., as Lessee ("Lessee"), and The David J. Joseph Company (subsequently "DJJ Transportation Services, Inc." and now known as "Joseph Transportation Services, Inc."), as Lessor, as subsequently assigned to Star Bank, N.A. (subsequently Firststar Bank, N.A.), as Lessor ("Lessor"), on October 15, 1997, as reflected in the Memorandum of Assignment and Assumption Agreement bearing Recordation No. 19380-A filed on October 29, 1997, with respect to two (2) of the sixty (60) railcars, WC 31236 and WC 31257, (hereinafter, the "Equipment").

WHEREAS, the Equipment has been destroyed and is no longer subject to the Lease;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Lessor submits the following:

1. All interest of the Lessee, its successors and assigns, in the Equipment arising pursuant to the Lease has been terminated.
2. The Lessor hereby releases any lien on the Equipment created by or arising out of the Lease.
3. This Release shall be recorded with the Surface Transportation Board so as to record the release of the lien against the Equipment constituted by the Lease, and shall bear Recordation No. 19380-C.


