MEMORANDUM OF ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

GREENBRIER LEASING CORPORATION

AND

BOMBARDIER CAPITAL RAIL INC.

AUGUST 30, 2000

Memorandum of Assignment and Assumption Agreement made and entered into as of August 30, 2000 by and between Greenbrier Leasing Corporation, a Delaware corporation, ("Assignor") and Bombardier Capital Rail Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("Assignee").

WITNESSETH:

1. Assignor, as Lessor, leased to Wisconsin Central Ltd. ("Lessee") one hundred (100) 50-foot, Plate C boxcars with 10-foot plug doors, nailable steel floors and 15-inch EOCC, marked and numbered WC 21300 through WC 21399, inclusive (the "Cars"), pursuant to that certain Lease Agreement dated June 1, 2000, and Rider No. 1 thereto dated as of June 1, 2000 (the "Lease").
2. Assignor has agreed to assign to Assignee and Assignee has agreed to accept from Assignor all of Assignor's right, title and interest in the Cars, as well as Assignor's right, title and interest under the Lease to the extent it relates to the Cars.
3. This Memorandum of Assignment Agreement may be executed by the parties hereto in any number of counterparts, and all counterparts taken together shall be deemed to constitute one instrument.






