Dear Mr. Williams:

I am enclosing for recording pursuant to Section 11301 of Title 49 of the United States Code, two original copies of each of the two primary documents described below and the two secondary documents described below. **MEMORANDUM OF LEASE AND INDENTURE SUPPLEMENT NO. 1
(UPRR 2000-B)**

Memorandum of Lease and Indenture Supplement No. 1, made and entered into as of September 28, 2000, by and between Wilmington Trust Company, a Delaware banking corporation, not in its individual capacity, but solely as Owner Trustee, as Lessor ("*Lessor*"), Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Delaware corporation, as Lessee ("*Lessee*") and First Security Bank, National Association, a national banking association, as Indenture Trustee ("*Indenture Trustee*").

WITNESSETH:

1. Lessee and Lessor have entered into that certain Lease Agreement (UPRR 2000-B), dated as of September 1, 2000 (the "*Lease Agreement*"), effective as of the date first set forth hereinabove and subject to the term defined in said Lease Agreement. Lessor and Indenture Trustee have entered into that certain Indenture and Security Agreement (UPRR 2000-B), dated as of September 1, 2000 (the "*Indenture*"), by which Lessor has granted a security interest to Indenture Trustee in order to secure Lessor's performance of certain obligations as described in the Indenture.

2. Memoranda of said Lease Agreement and said Indenture are being recorded with the Surface Transportation Board concurrently herewith pursuant to Section 11301 of Title 49 of the United States Code.

3. The undersigned have entered into that certain Lease and Indenture Supplement No. 1 (UPRR 2000-B), dated September 28, 2000, whereby the terms and provisions of the above-described Lease Agreement are made applicable to certain railroad equipment bearing reporting marks as listed on Exhibit A attached hereto and whereby Lessor has granted, pursuant to the above-described Indenture, a security interest therein to the railroad equipment leased to Lessee under the Lease Agreement.




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
