MEMORANDUM OF ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

GREENBRIER LEASING CORPORATION

Memorandum of Assignment and Assumption Agreement made and entered into as of May 31, 2001, by and between Greenbrier Leasing Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("Assignor"), and Bombardier Capital Rail Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("Assignee").

WITNESSETH:

1. Assignor, as Lessor, leased to Florida East Coast Railway, LLC ("Lessee"), one hundred (100) 85-foot, 110-ton, Plate C standard-level flatcars equipped for container service marked and numbered FEC 37000 through FEC 37099, inclusive, pursuant to that certain Lease Agreement dated May 1, 2000, and Rider No. 2 thereto dated as of October 1, 2000 (collectively, the "Lease").
2. Assignor has agreed to assign to Assignee and Assignee has agreed to accept from Assignor the Lease and the Cars which are the subject of that Lease.


