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SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD
RELEASE, RECONVEYANCE AND STATEMENT OF TRUSTEE

dated as of November 13, 2001

WHEREAS, The Canada Trust Company ("CTC") and Procor Limited (the "Company") entered into a Trust Indenture dated as of June 26, 1985 (the "Trust Indenture") whereby, among other things, the Company i) granted the Trustee (as such term is defined in the Trust Indenture) a security interest in, and mortgage on, the twenty-three (23) SD50F 3600 horse-power diesel-electric locomotives marked **CN 5408 to CN 5430 inclusive** (the "Equipment") and ii) assigned all its rights and interests in the Lease (as defined hereinbelow) to the Trustee;

WHEREAS, CTC, the Company and Montreal Trust Company of Canada ("MTCC") entered into i) a Supplemental Trust Indenture dated as of May 1, 1989 and ii) a Supplemental Trust Deed bearing formal date of May 1, 1989, whereby, among other things, MTCC succeeded CTC as Trustee under the Trust Indenture;

WHEREAS, the Company as lessor and Canadian National Railway Company (the "Lessee") as lessee entered into a Lease of Railroad Equipment dated as of June 26, 1985 (the "Lease") covering the Equipment;

AND WHEREAS, as of the date hereof, all amounts of principal and interest, due in connection with the Notes (as such term is defined in the Trust Indenture) issued pursuant to the Trust Indenture, have been paid or due provision has been made satisfactory to the Trustee for the payment of such amounts of principal and interest.


NOW THEREFORE, the Trustee hereby i) cancels and discharges the charges created on the Mortgaged Property (as such term is defined in the Trust Indenture) in Section 6.1 of the Trust Indenture (including, but without limitation, its security interest in, and mortgage on, the Equipment); ii) reconveys and reassigns unto the Company all right, title and interest of the Trustee in the Mortgaged Property (including, but without limitation, the Equipment and the Lease), iii) states that the title to the Equipment is free and clear of all liens, security interests and other encumbrances arising pursuant to the Trust Indenture.

Federal Recordation Particulars:

1) **Surface Transportation Board**

On July 8, 1985 at 3:30 P.M., the Lease was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission (predecessor to the Surface Transportation Board) pursuant to Section 11303 (now Section 11301) of Title 49 of the *United States Code* and assigned recordation number 14726. On August 1, 1985, the Trust Indenture was similarly filed and assigned recordation number 14759. On July 2, 1999 at 9:30 A.M., the Supplemental Trust Indenture was similarly filed and assigned secondary recordation numbers 14726-A and 14759-A.

2) **Registrar General of Canada**

On July 8, 1985, the Lease was deposited in the Office of the Registrar General of Canada pursuant to Section 86 (which became Section 90) of the *Railway Act of Canada* (now Section 105 of the *Canada Transportation Act*). On July 31, 1985, the Trust Indenture was similarly deposited. On June 22, 1999, such Supplemental Trust Indenture was similarly deposited. Notices, in respect of all such deposits, were published in the *Canada Gazette*.
