

WELLS FARGO BANK NORTHWEST, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION (formerly known as First Security Bank, (the "Assignee") does hereby acknowledge National Association) and declare that:

1. Pursuant to an Agreement and Assignment dated as of March 1, 1975, it is the Assignee for valuable consideration of all and singular the right, title and interest of PACCAR INC (the "Builder"), in, under and to a Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of March 1, 1975, as amended, between the Builder and WALTER E. HELLER & COMPANY (the "Vendee"), covering the construction, sale and delivery by the Builder to the Vendee of 493 50' 70-ton boxcars numbered WCTR 100500-100992, inclusive, which Conditional Sale Agreement and Agreement and Assignment, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11303 were filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on May 29, 1975 and assigned Recordation Nos. 7935 and 7935-D, respectively.

2. Pursuant to an Assignment of Lease and Agreement dated as of March 1, 1975, it is the Assignee for valuable consideration of all and singular the right, title and interest of Vendee, in, under and to the Lease of Railroad Equipment dated as of March 1, 1975, as amended, between Vendee, as Lessor, and WCTU RAILWAY COMPANY (the "Railway"), as Lessee, covering the lease by the Vendee to the Railway of 493 50' 70-ton boxcars numbered WCTR 100500-100992, inclusive, which Lease of Railroad Equipment and Assignment of Lease and Agreement, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11303 were filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on May 29, 1975 and assigned Recordation Nos. 7935-A and 7935-B, respectively.

3. All and singular the terms and conditions of said Conditional Sale Agreement to be by the Vendec done, carried out, complied with, and performed, including payment of the purchase price of the above-described railroad equipment, with interest thereon, have been duly done, carried out, complied with and performed; and

4. The Assignee hereby releases the above-described railroad equipment from liens and encumbrances created or retained in or by said Conditional Sale Agreement, said Agreement and Assignment, and said Assignment of Lease and Agreement.






