Dear Mr. Williams:

I am enclosing for recording pursuant to Section 11301 of Title 49 of the United States Code, two original copies of each of the two primary documents described below and two original copies of the secondary document described below. As one of the attorneys representing Lessee in this transaction, I have knowledge of the matters described in this letter.




