
MEMORANDUM OF RIDER 4

THIS MEMORANDUM OF RIDER 4 is effective as of March 3, 2004 by and between MIDWEST RAILCAR CORPORATION, an Illinois Corporation ("Lessor"), and OMNISOURCE CORPORATION, an Indiana Corporation ("Lessee"), with reference to the following:


