This Release of Lien of Railroad Equipment Lease (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Railroad Equipment Lease dated as of March 21, 2000 (the "Lease"), bearing Recordation No. 22926 and Railroad Equipment Lease dated December 11, 2002 (the "Lease"), bearing Recordation No. 24267 between The David J. WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee executed the Lease relating to the Equipment. Such Lease has expired; and



3. The Lessor hereby releases any lien(s) created by or arising out of the Lease.
4. This Release shall be recorded with the Surface Transportation Board so as to record the release of the lien(s) against the Equipment constituted by the Lease.
