RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

The undersigned, Security Benefit Corporation, both individually and as agent under that certain Agency Agreement dated as of April 1, 1985 originally among Security Benefit Trust Company (as predecessor in interest to Security Benefit Corporation), Security Pacific Financial Leasing, Inc., Security Benefit Life Insurance Company, The First Pyramid Life Insurance Company of America and Liberty Life Insurance Company, as Secured Party, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, terminates and releases its rights and interests (including without limitation any security interests, liens, chattel mortgages, and other rights and interests as secured party) in and to, or pursuant to, any or all of the following:

Rights and interests as a Secured Party pursuant to the Security Agreement, dated as of April 1, 1985 in favor of the Secured Party, by Security Benefit Corporation, as successor in interest to Security Benefit Trust Company ("Debtor"), as thereafter amended or supplemented (including, without limitation, by the First Assignment and the Second Assignment (as defined below)), with respect to the 215 railcars now numbered as PLWX 44558 through PLWX 44757 and PLWX 220354 through PLWX 220369.

The Security Agreement was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on April 30, 1985 at 11:20 a.m. under Recordation Number 14637. That certain Consent, Waiver, Amendment, Assignment and Assumption dated as of June 1, 1992 originally by and among Security Pacific Equipment Leasing, Inc. (as successor in interest to Security Pacific Financial Leasing, Inc.), as lessor, Security Benefit Group, Inc. (as successor in interest to Security Benefit Trust Company), as agent, Liberty Life Insurance Company, as lender, Security Benefit Life Insurance Company, as lender, ITEL Rail Corporation (as successor to Signal Capital Corporation), as assignor lessee, and GE Capital Railcar Associates, Inc., as assignee lessee (the "First Assignment") was originally filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on June 1, 1992 at 11:55 am under Recordation Numbers 14636-B and 14637-A. That certain Assignment and Assumption Agreement between Security Pacific Equipment Leasing, Inc., as assignor lessor, and BA Leasing & Capital Corporation, as assignee lessor (the "Second Assignment") was originally filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on January 3, 1995 at 12:40 pm under Recordation Numbers 14636-C and 14637-B. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Secured Party releases and terminates its rights and interests covered by the Security Agreement as amended.


