This Partial Release of Lien of Agreement (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Agreement dated as of February 20, 2003 (the "Agreement"), bearing Recordation No. 24396 and recorded on April 8, 2003 between The David J. Joseph Company (f/k/a Joseph Transportation Services, Inc.) as Lessor ("Lessor") and Ramp Management, LLC as Lessee ("Lessee"), with respect to the three (3) locomotives (hereinafter, the "Equipment").




1. Lessee has returned the Equipment to Lessor on November 11, 2003.
2. All interest of the Lessee, its successors and assigns, in the Equipment arising pursuant to the Agreement has been terminated.
3. The Lessor hereby releases any lien created by or arising out of the Agreement.
4. This Release shall be recorded with the Surface Transportation Board so as to record the partial release of the lien against the Equipment constituted by the Agreement bearing reporting marks; NIS 201 and NIS 202


