FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT JAN 05 05 9-19 PM

THIS FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT (this "Full Release") is given as of this 23rd day of December, 2005, by THRIVENT FINANCIAL FOR LUTHERANS (formerly known as Aid Association for Lutherans) (the "Lender"), witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the Lender, as lender, and The First National Bank of Maryland (predecessor-in-interest to Allfirst Bank, predecessor-by-merger to Manufacturers and Traders Trust Company) (the "Debtor"), as debtor, entered into that certain Security Agreement dated as of August 24, 1995 deposited with the Surface Transportation Board (the "STB") on August 24, 1995 under recordation number 19575 relating to covered hopper railcars described in Exhibit A attached thereto (collectively, the "Equipment").
