**MEMORANDUM OF FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND
RESTATED EQUIPMENT LEASE**

This Memorandum of Fourth Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease ("Memorandum"), made and entered into effective July 5, 2006, is by and between The Dow Chemical Company, a Delaware corporation, as Lessee ("Lessee"), and Wells Fargo Equipment Finance, Inc., a Minnesota corporation (successor to First Security Leasing Company), as Owner and Lessor ("Owner").

WITNESSETH:

A. WHEREAS, Lessee and Owner entered into that certain Equipment Lease dated as of November 15, 1983 (the "Equipment Lease"), which was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission (the "ICC") on December 9, 1983, and assigned Recordation Number 14213; and

B. WHEREAS, the Equipment Lease was amended pursuant to that certain Amended and Restated Equipment Lease dated as of March 1, 1985 (the "Amended Lease"), which was filed and recorded with the ICC on March 27, 1985, and assigned Recordation Number 14213-A; and

C. WHEREAS, the Amended Lease was further amended pursuant to that certain First Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease dated as of July 1, 1985 (the "First Amendment"), which was filed and recorded with the ICC on December 9, 1985, and assigned Recordation Number 14213-B (the Equipment Lease, Amended Lease and First Amendment being referred to herein collectively as the "Lease"); and

D. WHEREAS, the First Amendment was amended pursuant to that certain Second Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease dated as of July 5, 2004 (the "Second Amendment"), and a Memorandum of Second Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease was filed and recorded with the Surface Transportation Board (the successor to the ICC) on July 30, 2004, and assigned Recordation Number 14213-C; and

E. WHEREAS, the Second Amendment was amended pursuant to that certain Third Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease dated as of July 5, 2005 (the "Third Amendment") in which Lessee renewed the Lease for one Renewal Term, and a Memorandum of Third Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease was filed and recorded with the Surface Transportation Board on June 16, 2005, and assigned Recordation Number 14213-D (the Equipment Lease, Amended Lease, First Amendment, Second Amendment and Third Amendment being referred to hereinafter collectively as the "Lease"); and

F. WHEREAS, Lessee has notified Owner of its intent to renew the Lease.

NOW THEREFORE, Lessee and Owner hereby agree to a one-year renewal of the Lease and related Participation Agreement as to the Items of Equipment set forth in Exhibit A hereto, and in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in that certain Fourth Amendment to Amended and Restated Equipment Lease dated as of July 5, 2006 between the parties hereto, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference.

This Memorandum may be executed in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same Memorandum.


