This Release of Lien of Railroad Equipment Lease (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Railroad Equipment Lease dated as of March 23, 1998, and amended by agreement dated August 22, 2000 (the "Lease"), bearing Recordation Nos. 21396 and 21396-A, between The David J.
