LOCOMOTIVE OPERATING LEASE AGREEMENT TERMINATION

This Locomotive Operating Lease Agreement Termination dated as of June 30, 2000 (the "Termination") terminates the Locomotive Operating Lease Agreement, dated as of March 19, 1993 (the "Lease"), between General Motors Corporation (Electro-Motive Division) ("EMD"), a Delaware corporation, and Grand Trunk Western Railroad Inc. ("GTW").

WHEREAS, EMD and GTW executed a Locomotive Operating Lease Agreement, dated as of March 19, 1993, relating to the equipment described in Exhibit A hereto ("Locomotives");

WHEREAS, the Lease was duly filed for recordation with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11303 on April 28, 1993 at 9:50 a.m., and was filed under Recordation No. 18214; and

WHEREAS, EMD and GTW desire to terminate and cancel the Lease and to record this termination and cancellation;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is acknowledged, EMD and GTW agree as follows:

1. EMD and GTW hereby terminate and cancel the Lease.
2. EMD and GTW agree to record this Termination with the Surface Transportation Board so as to release the lien against the Locomotives constituted by the Lease.
3. This Termination may be executed by the parties in any number of counterparts, each executed counterpart constituting an original but altogether one and the same instrument.
