

PARTIAL RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENTS

Dated as of March 29, 2007

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD

WHEREAS, TRANS-GLOBAL SOLUTIONS, INC. ("TGS"), as debtor, and INTERNATIONAL BANK OF COMMERCE ("IBC"), as secured party, are parties to: (1) a Security Agreement dated as of May 9, 2000 between IBC and TGS, which was recorded at the Surface Transportation Board (the "STB") on June 15, 2000 at 2:20 pm under Recordation No. 22952; (2) a Security Agreement dated as of September 18, 2000 between IBC and TGS, which was recorded at the STB on October 5, 2000 at 2:20 pm under Recordation No. 22952-A; and (3) a Security Agreement dated as of June 30, 2004 between IBC and TGS, which was recorded at the STB on September 9, 2004 at 12:34 pm under Recordation No. 22952-D (collectively referred to as the "Security Agreements"), which granted IBC a security interest in all of TGS's now existing and hereafter arising equipment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the Security Agreements, IBC has agreed to release the security interests of the Security Agreements with respect to four GP40-1 locomotives numbered LLPX 189, 190, 191 and 193, and two SD38-2 locomotives numbered LLPX 2803 and 2804, including all title, right, and interest thereto as defined in the Security Agreements (the "Locomotives").

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, IBC agrees as follows:

The security interests created by or arising out of the Security Agreements on the Locomotives are hereby released.

This Partial Release shall not affect the security interests created by the Security Agreements on any rolling stock, equipment or other assets not identified herein. IBC hereby reaffirms the security interests on all other rolling stock, equipment and assets of TGS not identified herein. IBC acknowledges that this Partial Release will be recorded with the STB.
