**MEMORANDUM OF ASSIGNMENT
(Surface Transportation Board)**

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BOARD

THIS MEMORANDUM OF ASSIGNMENT effective as of July 3, 2008 ("Memorandum") is between First Union Rail Corporation ("Assignor") and Wachovia Financial Services, Inc. ("Assignee").

The parties to this Memorandum hereby acknowledge and confirm the following:

A. Assignor, as lessee, has leased from Wells Fargo Bank Northwest, National Association, as owner trustee, as lessor, certain railroad cars more particularly described on Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 4 attached hereto pursuant to Lease Supplement No. 1, Lease Supplement No. 2, Lease Supplement No. 3 and Lease Supplement No. 4 to that certain Equipment Lease Agreement (FURC Trust No. 2006-2A), each dated as of September 26, 2006 (hereinafter together as amended, modified, supplemented and or replaced from time to time as the "Lease"), evidence of which has been recorded pursuant to Memorandum of Lease Agreement, Lease Supplement No. 1, Lease Supplement No. 2, Lease Supplement No. 3 and Lease Supplement No. 4 with the Surface Transportation Board on September 26, 2006 and assigned recordation number 26572.

B. Assignor and Assignee are parties to that certain Assignment and Assumption Agreement (FURC Trust No. 2006-2A) dated as of the effective date hereof, pursuant to which Assignor has assigned all of its right, title, interest and obligations in and to the Lease and Assignee has assumed the obligations of Assignor under the Lease.

C. The parties hereto wish to show for public record this Memorandum and accordingly have caused this Memorandum to be executed by their officers thereunto duly authorized, as of the date first above written. This Memorandum may be executed in counterparts, each such counterpart shall be binding on both parties hereto, notwithstanding that both parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
