**MEMORANDUM OF AMENDED AND RESTATED EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION
(CNW 1994-B)**

Memorandum of Amended and Restated Equipment Description (CNW 1994-B) effective as of January 2, 2009, by and between U.S. Bank National Association (successor to Shawmut Bank Connecticut, National Association), a national banking association, not in its individual capacity, but solely as Owner Trustee of the CNW 1994-B Trust, as Lessor ("Lessor"), and Union Pacific Railroad Company (successor to Chicago and North Western Railway Company), a Delaware corporation, as Lessee ("Lessee").


