WHEREAS, AMEGY BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION ("Lender") is the owner and holder of certain indebtedness (the "Indebtedness") of SOUTHWEST RAIL INDUSTRIES, INC., a Texas corporation (the "Debtor"), which Indebtedness is secured by a lien on, among other things, certain railcars, pursuant to, among other instruments, that certain Twelfth Amendment to Security Agreement dated as of April 29, 2011 (the "Security Agreement"), filed with the Surface Transportation Board of the Department of Transportation under file number 22456-Y, covering, among other things, four (4) railcars, specifically:

four (4) 30,000 gallon railcars stencil numbers SRIX 30077, SRIX 30078, SRIX 30089 and SRIX 30091 (the "Four Rail Cars");

WHEREAS, Debtor has requested that Lender release the Four Rail Cars.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, Lender hereby RELEASES and DISCHARGES all liens, rights, titles, interests, assignments and security interests covering or related to the Four Rail Cars held by Lender, including the liens and security interests created by the Security Agreement in the Four Rail Cars.

The Indebtedness is not released by this Partial Release of Lien and Security Interest. The Indebtedness remains in effect.

It is expressly agreed and understood that this instrument is a PARTIAL RELEASE only and this instrument shall in no way release, affect or impair the liens, security interests or assignments against any property described in the Security Agreement or any other instrument securing payment of the Indebtedness, other than the Four Rail Cars, and all rights, title, liens and interests securing payment of the Indebtedness, to the extent they relate to any assets other than the Four Rail Cars released hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.
