Memorandum of Product Security Agreement

This Memorandum of Product Security Agreement is made and entered into as of April 23, 2013, by and between FREIGHTCAR AMERICA, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Secured Party") and EAST TEXAS ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Debtor").

Pursuant to the Purchase Order dated April 22, 2013 (the "PO Agreement") between Secured Party and Debtor, and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth, Secured Party has agreed to manufacture and sell to Debtor, and Debtor has agreed to purchase from Secured Party, certain Products, identified on Schedule A hereto (the "Products").


As security for the payment and fulfillment of its obligations to Secured Party under the PO Agreement, Debtor granted to Secured Party a security interest in the Products, together with all right, title and interest of Debtor therein and all rights and remedies which Debtor might exercise with respect thereto but for the execution of the PO Agreement.

As contemplated by the PO Agreement, Secured Party and Debtor hereby make this Memorandum of Product Security Agreement to confirm and perfect Secured Party's security interest in the Products. Secured Party and Debtor further acknowledge and confirm that this Memorandum of Product Security Agreement is neither a summary of the PO Agreement nor a complete recitation of the terms and provisions thereof. Accordingly, Secured Party and Debtor agree that in the event of a conflict between this Memorandum of Product Security Agreement and the provisions of the PO Agreement, the provisions of the PO Agreement shall control.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the parties hereto, pursuant to due authority, has caused this Memorandum of Product Security Agreement to be duly executed in its name by its officers, thereunto duly authorized, all as of the date first above written.






