**FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST**

The undersigned, The Bank of New York Mellon (successor to Mercantile-Safe Deposit and Trust Company), as Indenture Trustee (the "Indenture Trustee"), for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, does hereby terminate, release and discharge any and all security interests held by it on all railroad equipment, the Lease dated as of November 1, 1990 ("Lease") with CSX Transportation, Inc. and Owner Trustee and each Lease Supplement delivered under the Lease granted pursuant to the Indenture, Mortgage and Security Agreement, dated as of November 1, 1990, between Wilmington Trust Company, not in its individual capacity, but solely as Trustee, as Owner Trustee (the "Owner Trustee") and the Indenture Trustee, as amended and supplemented, including the Lease and Indenture Supplement No. 1 ("Supplement No. 1"), dated as of December 18, 1990, among the Owner Trustee, the Indenture Trustee and the Lessee.

The Loan and Security Agreement and Supplement No. 1 were duly filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on December 18, 1990 under Recordation Numbers 17130-A and 17130-B.
