**RELEASE OF EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, there was established a certain Equipment Trust Agreement, dated as of December 1, 1979, executed by Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, Trustee, United Equipment Leasing Associates, Issuer, and Evans Transportation Company, Guarantor, which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") on January 23, 1980 under Recordation No. 11416 ("Agreement");

WHEREAS, the indebtedness secured by the Agreement, together with interest and all other payments as provided therein, has been repaid in full;

WHEREAS, Bank of America, N.A. has succeeded to the interest of Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago as Trustee;

WHEREAS, Archer Daniels Midland Company ("ADM") succeeded to the obligations of United Equipment Leasing Associates;

NOW THEREFORE, the Trustee, in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement, does hereby terminate, release, and discharge any and all security interests held by it with respect to the Equipment ("Equipment" meaning all railcars described in the Agreement and any supplement or other amendatory document thereafter filed with the ICC as a secondary document under Recordation No. 11416).


This instrument shall be binding upon the Trustee and inure to the benefit of ADM and its successors and assigns.
