RELEASE OF TRUST INDENTURE AND SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS RELEASE OF TRUST INDENTURE AND SECURITY AGREEMENT is made as of December 30, 2011 by **Wells Fargo Bank Northwest, N.A.** not in its individual capacity but solely as trustee.

WHEREAS, First Security Bank, National Association (now known as **Wells Fargo Bank Northwest, N.A.**) (the "Indenture Trustee") and **Pitney Bowes Credit Corporation** (predecessor-in-interest to **EntreCap Financial LLC**) as borrower (the "Borrower") entered into a Trust Indenture and Security Agreement dated as of January 21, 1997, as amended or supplemented, (the "Indenture") whereby, among other things, the Indenture Trustee held a security interest in i) the Lease (as defined below) and ii) the six-hundred (600) 5,150 cu. ft. covered hopper freight cars bearing the reporting marks **IC 799200 to IC 799799 inclusive** (the "Equipment");

WHEREAS, the original Indenture was filed at the Surface Transportation Board on January 31, 1997 at 11:20 A.M. with secondary recordation number 20448-B;

WHEREAS, Borrower and **Illinois Central Railroad Company** entered into a Master Rail Lease Agreement No. 7783699 dated as of December 27, 1996 and Lease Schedule No. 001 thereto dated as of December 27, 1996 (collectively, the "Lease") covering the Equipment; and

WHEREAS, Borrower has fully discharged and satisfied its obligations under the Indenture.

NOW THEREFORE, Indenture Trustee hereby confirms that Borrower has fully discharged and satisfied its obligations under the Indenture, releases all claims against Borrower and releases all its estate, right, title and interest in the Indenture Estate (as defined in the Indenture) which includes, among other things, the Lease and the Equipment.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Indenture Trustee has caused this Release of Trust Indenture and Security Agreement to be executed, by its officer thereunto duly authorized, as of the day and year first above written and such officer declares pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746 under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is a true and correct document.


