RELEASE OF EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, there was established a certain Equipment Trust Agreement, dated as of March 15, 1979, executed by Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, Trustee, United Equipment Leasing Associates, Issuer, and Evans Transportation Company, Guarantor, which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission (“ICC”) on May 1, 1979 under Recordation No. 10327 (“Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the indebtedness secured by the Agreement, together with interest and all other payments as provided therein, has been repaid in full;

WHEREAS, Bank of America, N.A., has succeeded to the interest of Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago as Trustee;


