



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

**AGREEMENT** dated March 22, 1957, between **THE STATE STREET CORPORATION** (hereinafter called the Lessor), and **BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD**, a corporation organized under the laws of Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire and New York (hereinafter called the Lessee).

In consideration of the payment of the sum of \$10 to Lessor, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Lease of Railroad Equipment dated January 10, 1957 (hereinafter called the Lease) between Lessor and Lessee, is hereby amended so that the amount of monthly rental is changed from \$56.71, each and every time it appears in the Section, to read \$56.68.

2. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts together shall constitute but one and the same instrument, which shall be sufficiently evidenced by any such original counterpart. Although this Agreement is dated for convenience as set forth herein, the actual date or dates of execution hereof by the parties hereto is or are, respectively, the date or dates stated in the acknowledgments hereto annexed.
