



BILL OF SALE



WHEREAS, by a Trust Agreement and Assignment dated as of March 1, 1957 (the "Agreement"), between The State Street Corporation, a Delaware Corporation (the "Company"), and The Hanover Bank (now Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company), a New York Corporation (the "Trustee"), the Company assigned, transferred and set over unto the Trustee, upon the terms, conditions and trusts set forth in the Agreement, 300 50-ton steel railroad gondola cars bearing the numbers 9600 - 9899, inclusive (the "Cars");

WHEREAS, the conditions to discharge of the Agreement, provided in Section 4.1 thereof, have been performed and the Trustee desires to confirm title to the Cars in the Company by a bill of sale covering the Cars, without warranty; and


WHEREAS, the Car bearing number 9758 was destroyed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Trustee does release the 299 50-ton steel railroad gondola cars bearing the numbers 9600 - 9757 and 9759 - 9899, inclusive, from all of the provisions of the Agreement and does hereby assign, transfer, convey and set over all of the Trustee's right, title and interest in and to the aforesaid Cars unto the Company, its successors and assigns, free and clear of any and all liens and encumbrances created or existing by reason of said Agreement.




