CHARTER SUPPLEMENT NO. 6

THIS CHARTER SUPPLEMENT NO. 6, dated December 10, 1981, to Bareboat Charter dated as of October 1, 1981 (the "Charter") between DRAVO MECHLING CORPORATION (the "Charterer") and THE CONNECTICUT BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, not in its individual capacity but solely as owner trustee under the Trust Agreement dated as of October 1, 1981 between it and New England Merchants Leasing Corporation B-7 (in its capacity as such owner trustee, the "Shipowner").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Charter provides for the execution and delivery on the Delivery Date of a Vessel or Vessels of a Charter Supplement, substantially in the form hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and sufficient consideration, the Shipowner and the Charterer hereby agree as follows:

(1) The Shipowner hereby confirms that it has let, chartered and demised to the Charterer under the

Charter, and the Charterer hereby confirms that it has unconditionally accepted and hired from the Shipowner under the Charter, for all purposes thereof the following numbered Vessel(s) (the "delivered Vessel(s)") with the Official Number and designation by the Charterer as follows:
