NOTICE OF INTENT TO PARTICIPATE OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Introduction

Pursuant to Decision No. 6 of the Surface Transportation Board ("STB" or "Board") in the above-referenced matter, the United States Department of Transportation ("DOT" or "Department") hereby gives notice of its intent to participate in this proceeding. ¹ The Board herein will consider the application of CSX Corporation and CSX Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT"), Norfolk Southern Corporation and Norfolk Southern Railway Company ("NS"), and Conrail, Inc. and Consolidated Rail Corporation ("Conrail") to acquire control of Conrail and to divide its assets. ²

The proposed transaction is the first major railroad consolidation case in the Eastern United States since the Staggers Act. It encompasses over 44,000 miles of rail lines and related facilities and would fundamentally change all three of the major railroads in the East. If approved it will have major implications for transportation services, economic development, and community life in this, the most populated and heavily industrialized area of the country. The Department intends to review thoroughly all aspects of the proposed acquisition, as it has done in past mergers, and to make recommendations to the Board an appropriate. Additionally, as a result of our experience in other recent mergers of large railroad con panies, the Department will also closely scrutinize the safety implications of the transaction.

^{1/} The Department selects the acronym "DOT" for use in this proceeding.

^{2/} Conrail, NS, and CSX are referred to herein collectively as "Applica" ..."

Safety and Rail Consolidations

CSXT, NS, and Conrail are widely recognized as successful and well-run transportation companies with long-standing commitments to safety. All have been responsive to the safety concerns of the Federa! Railroad Administration ("FRA"), the operating administration of the Department responsible for overseeing the safety of railroad operations, and all have participated in FRA's Safety Assurance and Compliance Program, in which railroad and FRA officials jointly review carrier safety standards and practices. However, the proposed transaction is the most costly in the history of the industry and the first involving the division of a Class I carrier by two others. As noted, it also involves rail systems situated in the most populated and industria ized parts of the country. Consequently, the Department is aware that the negotiation and preparation of the proposed transaction, as well as the continuing planning and preparation necessary to the anticipated integration of these rail systems, have required a significant commitment of human and financial resources of the Applicants. The Department is committed to assuring that the task of the proposed acquisition not result in a diminution of resources necessary to guarantee continuing effective safety programs by the Applicants.

Previous mergers have given rise to concerns about the timely, effective integration of different corporate cultures as they relate to safety. To address similar concerns in connection with the proposed transaction, "safety action teams" are being as ablished to focus on operational and safety issues on NS and Conrail. The CSXT safety team, instituted after a series of high-profile accidents, already is working in partnership with CSXT management and railroad labor to conduct a comprehensive review of operational and safety issues at CSXT. Although this CSXT effort was not initiated specifically because of the proposed transaction, its scope will be expended consistent with those of the NS and Conrail reviews to assure continued safe operation of all of the Applicants' rail systems during this proceeding and any subsequent implementation and integration period.

As in previous mergers, if the application is approved the Applicants understandably will strive to realize the efficiencies projected in their operating plan at soon as possible. However, this goal cannot be reached at the expense of maintaining a safe railroad. Particularly when the transaction covers three rail systems as extensive as those of the Applicants, it is imperative that there be a fundamental commitment to safety throughout the new entities, with unified safety plans and programs over their entire systems. Integration of operations and services should proceed only when management and FRA are confident that safe and uniform operating practices have been implemented.

. .3 .

FRA has identified several specific areas in which safety concerns have arisen during the transition period in other recent mergers of large railroad companies, *i.e.*, the Union Pacific ("UP") and Southern Pacific ("SP") railroads (collectively, "UPSP") and the Burlington Northern ("BN") and Acheson, Topeka & Santa Fe ("SF") railroads (collectively, "BNSF"). Among others, those areas include:

1) train control systems,

2) training and quality control at central dispatch centers,

3) train inspections and identification of hazardous material defects, and

hours of service for train crews.

The Department is concerned that the process of integrating the different corporate cultures of such large entities may have adversely affected the ongoing safety programs of the UPSP and BNSF, and we raised these issues in our filing in the UPSP oversight proceeding. F.D. No. 32761 (Sub-No. 21). The acquisition proposed in this case involves rail carriers of similar size, and it has generated similar concerns within DOT. The Department has therefore taken steps so that, if this application is approved by the Board, the safety programs of the three Applicants will not suffer during the implementation and integration period following approval.

To that end, the safety teams now assessing Conrail, CSXT, and NS will also scrutinize any proposed changes in operating and maintenance practices required by the integration process so that they will not result in adverse safety impacts. FRA intends to conduct an in-depth assessment of all these railroads as part of this process, and will deliver its findings to the Board, along with its action plans to address significant safety issues.

The Department may also submit recommendations addressing ways to ensure the safest possible integration of the merging railroads. These recommendations may include a request for the imposition of conditions that may be necessary to assure safety.

Conclusion

The Department intends to participate actively in this case. We will address critical issues relevant to safety, particularly between now and the prospective completion of the Applicants' operational plans, as well as matters traditionally of concern to DOT in rail consolidation proceedings.

National Mining Association (NMA), in accordance with STB Finance Docket No. 33388, Decision No. 6, Notice of Issuance of Procedural Schedule, Effective Date May 30. 1997, expresses NMA's intent to participate in this proceeding.

IDENTITY AND INTEREST OF THE NATIONAL MINING ASSOCIATION

National Mining Association (NMA) is the industry association representing companies engaged in mining and minerals processing, manufacturing and supplying mining and minerals processing machinery, equipment, materials, and services, and others associated with extracting and processing coal, metallic ores, and other nonmetallic minerals in the United States. Coal producers together with producers of other

mine commodities such as phosphate rock must rely in many locations on dependable, efficient, and competitive rail carrier services for shipments from mines to utility and other industrial plants, to facilities engaged in producing an array of items for consumption in markets for commercial goods and agricultural chemicals, to construction operations, and to inland and coastal ports for transshipment of railroad freight using shallow-draft and deep-draft dry-bulk vessels utilized in domestic commerce and in U.S. export trade. The matter before the STB would lead to a massive restructuring of railroad transportation from the Atlantic Coast to the Mississippi River and from Canada to the Gulf of Mexico. Many of the states in the east which are located in that area have substantial mining and minerals processing op_rations; and, to varying degrees, all represent places where mine commodities, e.g. coal for fueling electric power and other minerals consumed in manufacturing and agriculture sectors, must rely on railroad transportation services for delivery.

CONCLUSION

It is imperative that companies functioning in the mining and minerals processing industry, along with the consumers of mine commodities, actively seek and support preservation and enhancement of dependable, efficient, and competitive rail carrier services essential for movement of freight in the eastern U.S. With that in mind, NMA hereby furnishes notification of NMA's intent to participate in STB Finance Docket No. 33388, realizing the matter has significant implications for railroad transportation.


