Dear Mr. Kucinich:

I attended the hearing held at the Lakewood City Auditorium yesterday and was very pleased by the large turnout. Such attendance, demonstrates the concerns we all have about the devastating impact on the quality of life in our communities that would result, should the proposed increase in rail traffic be approved.

The "it has already happened" language/attitude (never "proposed" or "if", always "when" we...) by the railroad company spokesmen was not only disheartening but disrespectful to the way the system is suppose to work. I could not believe my ears when he further stated, "It is too soon to panic." How arrogant and condescending can you get.

While Ms. Molitoris, a member of the Department of Transportation in Washington, D.C. which will decide the fate of our communities, seemed objective in her few comments at the onset of the meeting, her comments to the media after the meeting were not encouraging at all (something along the lines of, "..... would be the safest means of transport....."). It was stated that, due to possible future litigation, Ms. Molitoris could not address specific questions from the attendees; however, she did find it acceptable to make such a statement to the media after the conclusion of the meeting.

I applaud all the politicians (Kucinich, LaTorret, Westbrook, the rep from Mayor White's office, etc.) who each confirmed the known problems with which we will all have to deal, if the proposed increased rail traffic throughout Cleveland's western suburbs is approved, and Mike Dalton of the Surface Transportation Board for attending the meeting. Making the safety of the citizens the paramount concern, hit the nail right on the head. Because the tracks bi-sect our cities, it was noted by all, this could cut off access to fire, police and emergency response squads to a large percentage of the citizens, if track-crossing access is blocked.

As a citizen of the city of Rocky River, I was embarrassed that our city leaders did not find the need to attend the meeting. Not only did the mayor decide that he had other more important things to do (and he may legitimately have had a prior unbreakable commitment), but he did not even find the meeting important enough to send a city representative in his/the city's behalf.

In contrast, we saw Bay Village's mayor, chief of police and fire chief, as well as the mayors from Avon Lake and Lakewood, DeGrandis, head of Columbia Westshore Hospital, doctors Lateman, Pelini, Hastings and Rand, surgical nurse Wagner, EMS employee Silvison, etc.; all who recognized and responded to the importance of attending and participating in this hearing. (I apologize for any misspelling of names or unintentional omissions of others who spoke at the meeting.)

After reading the enclosed article, it is with great concern that I submit this letter to the Secretary of the Surface Transportation Board.

As a resident of Rocky River, Ohio, I wish to express my concerns regarding the devastating impact that will result, if the Conrail/Norfolk Southern merger, with the proposed subsequent dramatic increase in freight traffic through the western suburbs of Cleveland, is approved by your Board. Already, the residents of the communities listed in the attached article, as well as others in the cities of Lorain, Vermilion, etc. bordering Lake Erie, have to deal with the noise, inconvenience of blocked tracks preventing travel to and from the south and north portions of the cities, hazardous waste spill worries, noise and air pollution, and the obvious serious interference with the police, emergency-rescue squads, and the fire department vehicles answering emergency calls because the track crossings are blocked. Our school-aged children already have the hazard of walking over these busy rail crossings to attend school, and the thought of all these children dealing with more danger caused by the increased freight traffic is extremely frightening.

If it was possible for your Board to visit the communities west of Cleveland to see first hand the impact the proposed increase in freight traffic (from 14 to 38 trains per day) will create, the Board could then appreciate the legitimate concerns. These tracks do not run on the outskirts of these communities, but instead run right through the center of the residential districts. As the article states, the city of Lakewood alone has 27 crossings. The increase in freight traffic could virtually tie up these cities' ability to protect its citizens, as well as prevent the citizens from having the ability to freely travel within their own city limits. Why should these communities and their citizens have to suffer to accommodate an increased profit for the rail companies. Already it is impossible some nights to sleep due to the noise created by the already too heavily traveled tracks, now we are told the matter could get dramatically worse.

First reports that the tracks would no longer be used for the transportation of freight, but would be turned over for the Cleveland Rapid Transit Authority (RTA) for commuter trains were heralded. Now the communities read that these plans have fallen through, and the already unbearable freight traffic will be almost tripled. Who is to say that once the increased number of freight cars start roaring through our communities the freight traffic will not be quadrupled, or worse.

To the members of the Federal Railroad Administration and to Congressman Kucinich:

We are writing you this letter in response to the proposed increase railroad traffic announced by Norfolk Southern Railroad. **We strongly oppose Norfolk Southern's plan to triple the number of trains traveling the tracks in our hometown of Rocky River, Ohio.**

We oppose this plan for the following reasons:

1. DECREASED ACCESS TO EMERGENCY SERVICES

We see that access to our home and many of our neighbors will be hampered by this increase in traffic. Emergency vehicles will be unable to reach many residents in a timely fashion; when time is often of the essence.

2. INCREASE RISK OF TRAIN ACCIDENTS

Rocky River, as well as our suburban neighbors, is attractive to residents because of their location and serenity. The increase in traffic will only increase the risk to ALL the citizens in these neighborhoods; especially our young.

3. INCREASE OF DEBRIS

The trains do leave behind a noticeable amount of debris such as oil. As boat owners we have noticed debris, from the tracks, that land on the boats in the Rocky River basin.

4. NOISE POLLUTION

Every suburb, to our knowledge, has ordinances against excessive noise. If this were the case then we would propose that the trains far exceed this ordinance. As taxpayers we would request that an acoustic engineer be brought in to measure the noise. Living near the tracks we can tell you that the trains are far more disruptive than loud cars or stereos; which by the way have never been a problem in our neighborhood.
