
Re: 49 CFR §1250.4 - Rail Infrastructure Projects Reporting
September 1, 2019 Update

Dear Director Marvin:

Per 49 CFR §1250.4, The Kansas City Southern Railway Company (“KCS”), a Class I railroad, is required to notify the Board by March 1 of each calendar year of any significant rail infrastructure projects¹ planned for the year, and to provide the Board a six-month update on those projects by September 1. In March, KCS reported that it did not have any such projects planned for 2019. KCS is filing this report to confirm that it still does not have any “significant rail infrastructure projects”, as defined by the Board’s regulation, planned for 2019.

¹ A “significant rail infrastructure project” is defined as a project with anticipated expenditures of \$75 million or more over the life of the project. 49 CFR §1250.4(b)
