

An operate company is one whose efficers direct the business of transportation a whose books contain operating as well as financial accounts, and lessor company, the property of which being leased to and operated another company is one that maintains a separate legal existence a keeps financial out not operating accounts. In making reports, less companies use Annual Report Form R-4

Operating companies (including switching and terminal) are broat classified, with respect to their operating revenues, according to a following general definitions:

Class I companies are those having annual operating revenues of \$5,000,000 or more. For class, Annual Report 7, cris R-1 is provided.

Class I! compenies are those having annual operating revenues below \$5,00a,000. For class. Annual Report Form R-2 is provided.

In applying this classification to any switching or terminal compawhich is operated as a joint facility of owning or tenan' railways, sum of the annual railway operating revenues, the joint facility raincorae, and the returns to joint facility credit accounts in operat expenses, shall be used in determining its class.

Switching and terminal companies are further classified as:

Clas S1. Exclusively switching. This class of companies includes all those perfort switching service only, whether for joint account or for revenue.

This class of companies includes all companies furnisterminal tracitage or ter ainal facilities only, such as cation passenger or freight statistics of sock and sock, etc., for which a charge is made, whether operated for joint account of the reversity as a bridge or ferry is a part of the facilities operated by a terminal company, it should included under this heading.

Class S3. Both switching and terminal. Companies which perform both a switching at terminal service. This class of companies includes all companies whose operations cover t switching and terminal services, as defined above.

Class S4. Bridge and ferry. The class of companies is confined to hose whose operations limited to bridges and ferries exclusively.

Class S5. Mixes. Companies performing primarily a switching of a terminal or lice, but where conduct a regular freight or passenger traffic. The revenues of this class of companies in distributed in a switching or terminal resembles, those derived from local passer service, local freight service, participation in through movement of freight or passenger traffice, training station operations, and operations other than transportation.


