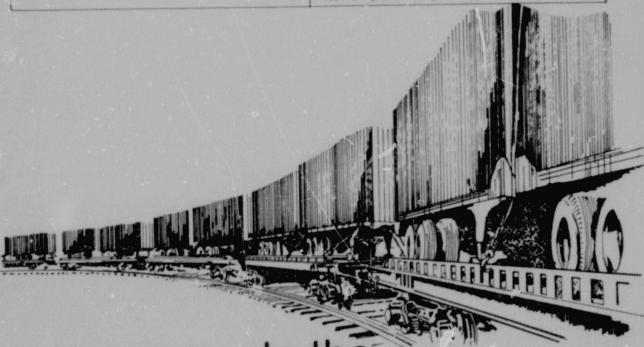

# LEASES

Effective in 1978 the company leased 25 box cars from United States Railway Leasing Company at \$336.50 per month per car and 30 box cars from United States Leasing Company at \$281.50 per car per month. The leases were assumed from Coin Millwork Company, Prineville, Oregon with expiration dates of August 19, 1978 and November 11, 1987, respectively. The 25 car lease has been extended into 1979 pending renegotiation of both leases.
